From BioStar 2.7.1, you can distinguish if the user is updated from device or server.
FW should be compatible with BioStar 2.7.1.

- BioEntry W2: 1.3.0 or later
- FaceStation 2: 1.2.0 or later
- CoreStation: 1.2.0 or later
- BioEntry P2: 1.2.0 or later
- BioEntry R2: 1.2.0 or later
- BioLite N2: 1.1.0 or later
- XPass D2: 1.1.0 or later
- OM-120: 1.1.0 or later
- Secure I/O 2: 1.2.4 or later
- DM-20: 1.1.4 or later
