Tailgating

One of the fraudulent authentication-based access methods where a person without permission to access a restricted zone enters the restricted zone following the preceding person who has access permissions.

Also called 'two-person entry,' tailgating is one of the most typical methods of gaining unauthorized access along with [Piggybacking](#). Generally, tailgating refers to the act of gaining unauthorized access without intent, while piggybacking generally refers to the act of gaining unauthorized access with intent.
