## BS2\_ResponseUserPhrase

[+ 2.7.0] Transfers the user phrase to the device.

### Declaration

```
#include "BS_API.h"

int BS2_ResponseUserPhrase(void* context, uint32_t deviceId, uint16_t seq,
int handleResult, const BS2_USER_PHRASE userPhrase);
```

### Parameter

- [In] *context* : Context
- [In] *deviceId* : Device ID
- [In] *seq* : Packet sequence number
- [In] *handleResult* : Matching result (BS\_SDK\_SUCCESS or BS\_SDK\_ERROR\_XXX)
- [In] *userPhrase* : Matched user phrase

#### NOTE

Packet sequence number must be equivalent to the value sent from the OnVerifyUser.

### Return Value

If successfully done, BS\_SDK\_SUCCESS will be returned.  
If there is an error, the corresponding error code will be returned.
