If function is called successfully, the device will revert to the default key value, and all data on the device will be erased.

Declaration

```
#include "BS_API.h"

int BS2_RemoveDataEncryptKey(void* context, uint32_t deviceId);
```

Parameter

- [In] *context* : Context
- [In] *deviceId* : Device ID

Return Value

If successfully done, BS_SDK_SUCCESS will be returned.

If there is an error, the corresponding error code will be returned.
