

How to Configure a Device Administrator

In BioStar 2, you can configure device administrators that have different privileges. It is also necessary to configure a device administrator to lock the device menu from being accessed by all users.

Configuring an Administrator to Lock the Menu

- 1. Click on the **DEVICE** menu.
- 2. Click on the device you would like to configure.



- 3. Scroll down to the **Advanced** tab.
- 4. On the All item click +Add.
- 5. Select a user.



6. Click **Apply** at the bottom of the page.

Check that the device menu is locked. Only the device administrator will be able to access the menu after inputting credentials.
