

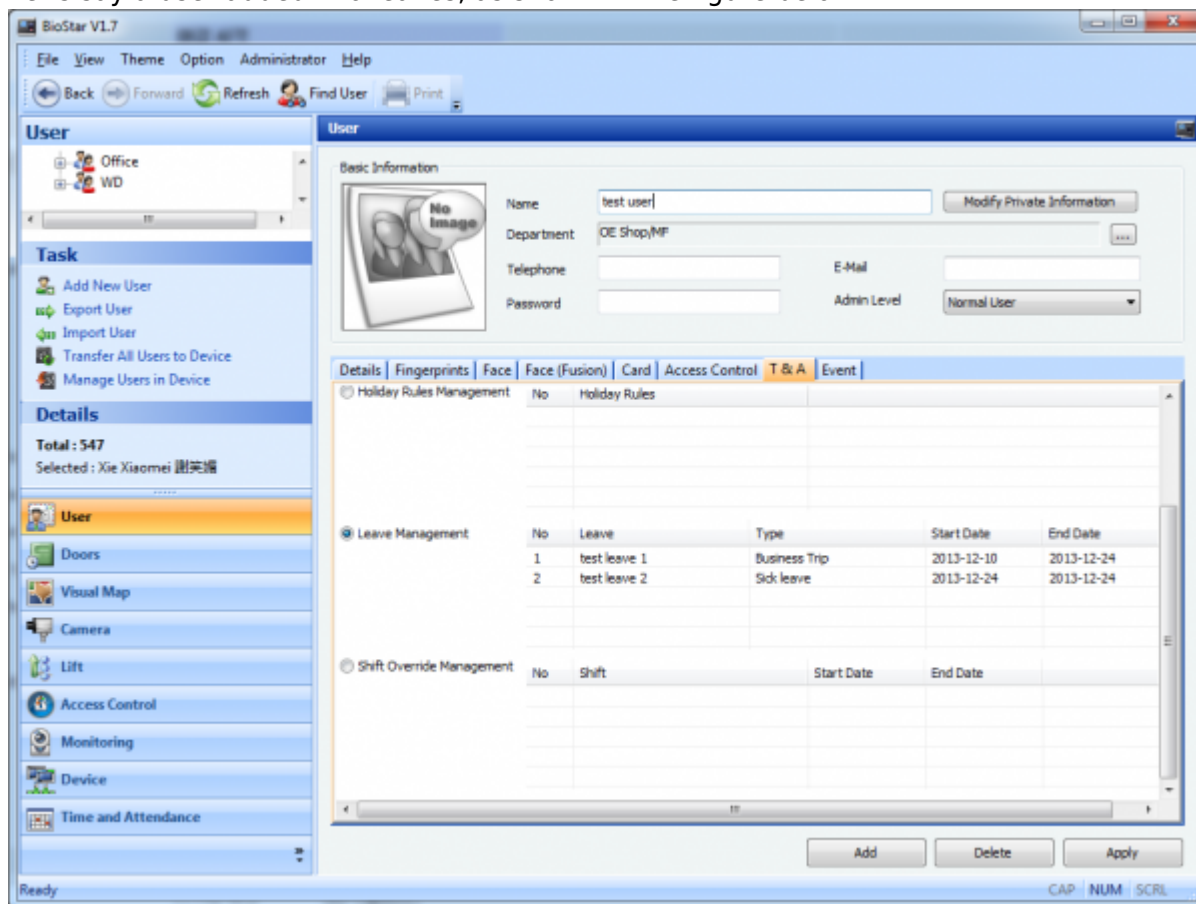

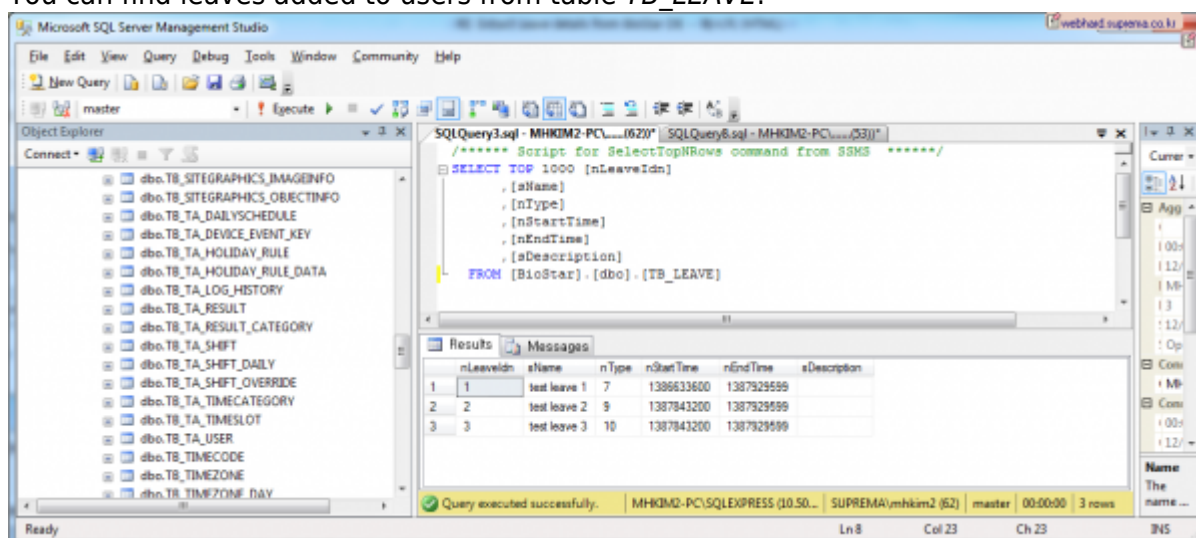

# How to get leave data from the BioStar database

Let's say a user added two leaves, as shown in the figure below:

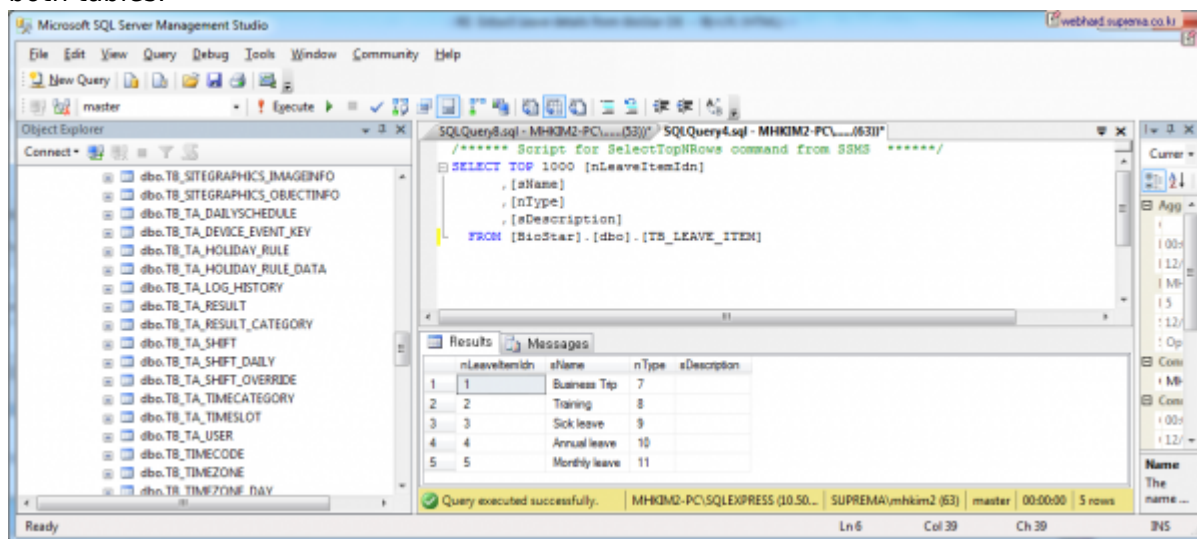


You can find leaves added to users from table *TB\_LEAVE*.

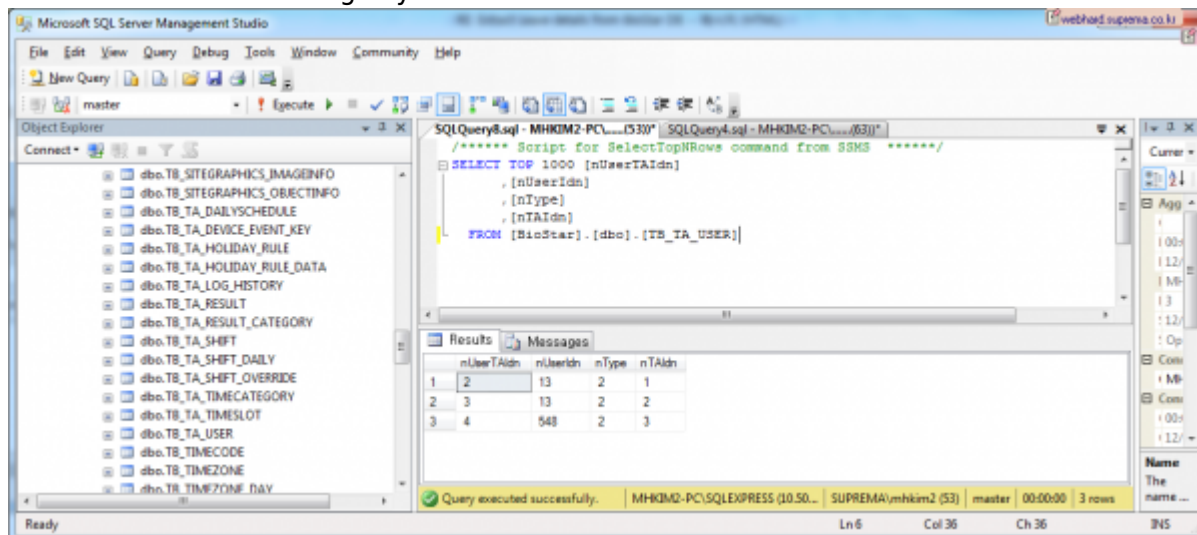


You can find which type these leaves are of from table *TB\_LEAVE\_ITEM*. Compare the column *nType* in

both tables.



You can find who have these leaves from table *TB\_TA\_USER*. You can use columns *nTAIdn* and *nUserTAIdn* as a matching key.
